Step 2: Project Application

- New and renewal projects who are invited to complete a full application will be asked to submit their project application and supplemental documents to the NWCoC via email to Barbara Johnson at barbaraj@nwmf.org.
- The application timeline and materials will be available on the NWCoC NOFO page.
- Projects will be scored and ranked by the CoC Ranking & Review Committee based on scoring and ranking criteria that was approved by the CoC Board.
