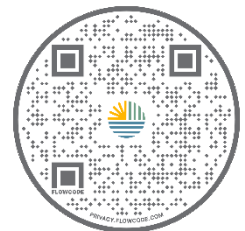
The FACF will consider grant applications with a minimum grant amount of \$500. A total amount available for 2025 grants of \$10,000.
